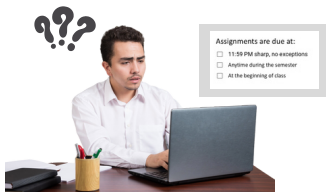




SYLLABUS QUIZ

Get students to read the syllabus and use it!



Why Use a Syllabus Quiz?

- Let's be honest... most students don't read the syllabus.
- A quiz makes it active, fun, and unforgettable.
- Fewer "When is this due?" questions and emails.
- Tells students: You're responsible for your own learning.
- Promotes agency, collaboration, and integrity.

What's In It For You?

- Make students actively use the syllabus as a guide to learning.
- No more repeating the same answers 20 times
- Expectations crystal clear from Day 1
- Students see the course as fresh, engaging, and organized
- Everyone literally starts on the same page!

Sample Questions

- When are assignments due?
- What happens if I submit late?
- When are the exams, and are make-ups allowed?
- How do I contact the instructor?
- What should I do before each class session?
- Can I use Ai?
- Where can I go for help if I don't understand the material?

How to Implement It?

- Create questions and upload them to Moodle.
- Give the quiz in class or assign it as homework in Moodle.
- If given in class, ask students to work together to find answers.
- Debrief to clear confusion, fix mistakes, and stress key policies.
- Remind students the syllabus is their main guide for the semester.



Bonus Tip

- Run it in the first week of class.
- Use Moodle, Kahoot, Google Forms, or paper.
- Add a small prize or participation points (candy, bonus points).
- Let students talk it out as discussion works better than lecturing.
- End with a reflection: "What in the syllabus will help you succeed?"
